Malka Nedivi's art practice is her way of dealing with both her and her parents' unknown past. Creating this body of work has been an emotional process of uncovering memories from her childhood. Her mother was a seamstress and was always fixing holes in old clothes. Nedivi believes she was trying to mend her past. In her own work, Nedivi layers fabric, paper and other mixed media elements from her childhood to create this remarkable, emotional body of work. Her figures began to take form in large scale sculptures and collage paintings on wood and canvas.

An artist living and working In Los Angeles, Nedivi's work has been featured in the LA Art Show and BOA Gallery. She was also chosen as one of the ten Southern California Contemporary Artists from Israel at the LA Municipal Art Gallery in Los Angeles. Nedivi recently directed a feature documentary about her relationship with her mother.
