**Hundreds of Women to Perform a  
"Constitution Drop" at the U.S. Capitol  
Calling on Grassley, Senate Judiciary Committee to #DoYourJob**

*NCJW to Call On Senate Republicans, Judiciary Committee for  
Timely Approval of Supreme Court Nominee*

Washington D.C - In response to the Senate Judiciary Committee Chairman Chuck Grassley's stated refusal to consider President Obama's Supreme Court nominee and ongoing partisan obstruction of nearly 40 judicial nominees to federal court vacancies nationwide, hundreds of women from around the country will participate in an action in front of the Capitol on **Tuesday, March 15, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. ET**, calling on the Senate to do its job and stop stalling on filling the Supreme Court vacancy.

As part of the action organized by the National Council for Jewish Women (NCJW), the women will walk in silent procession to the U.S. Capitol, bearing copies of the United States Constitution and messages to be delivered to Senator Chuck Grassley, Chair of the Senate Judiciary Committee. The action will highlight the unprecedented partisan obstruction the U.S. is facing when it comes to filling the Supreme Court vacancy and other judicial seats, delaying justice and diminishing our democracy.
