Hundreds of Volunteers Needed for NCJW | LA's Annual Clothing Giveaway and Community Resource Fair

LOS ANGELES, Calif.—**The Annual Clothing Giveaway**—an event hosted by the National Council of Jewish Women | Los Angeles (NCJW | LA) – will take place on Sunday, December 3, 2017 rain or shine, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. In keeping with its mission to improve the quality of life for women, children, and families, NCJW | LA invites in-need and at-risk members of the community to select from thousands of pieces of clothing and children's books. Attendees will also be able to receive information from local social service providers at the Community Resource Fair.

The event will be held in the parking lot of NCJW | LA Council House, 543 N. Fairfax Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90036.

NCJW | LA's eight Council Thrift Shops provided more than 2,000 people with 75,000 pieces of clothing at last year's Clothing Giveaway. The attendees learn of the event through local community service programs, schools and government agencies that serve the greater Los Angeles area. Over 250 volunteers donate their time to make this event possible.

Social service agencies will be distributing information about their programs and services at the Community Resource Fair, located on Clinton Street just west of Fairfax.
